- Unique research identifiers
- Your research identity online
- Scholarly profile management

# UNIQUE RESEARCH IDENTIFIERS

- Distinguish yourself from other researchers.
- Can be connected to journal and grant submissions
- Required by many funders and publishers.

# ORCID

- [orcid.org](https://orcid.org) (Open Researcher and Contributor ID)
  - Unique – won't change with name changes, or if other researchers share your name
  - Can be used continuously, even if you change institutions
- [Auto-update ORCID with CrossRef](#)
- Connects to other scholarly profiles

# YOUR RESEARCH IDENTITY ONLINE

- Ensure that your online presence is accurate and current.
- Website/blog
- Information on your university website
- Social media
  - Is there a popular platform within your field of expertise?
  - Consider keeping your personal and professional profiles separate

- Mendeley
- Academia.edu
- LinkedIn
- Scopus ID
- Researcher ID (connects to Web of Science)
- And other discipline-specific platforms

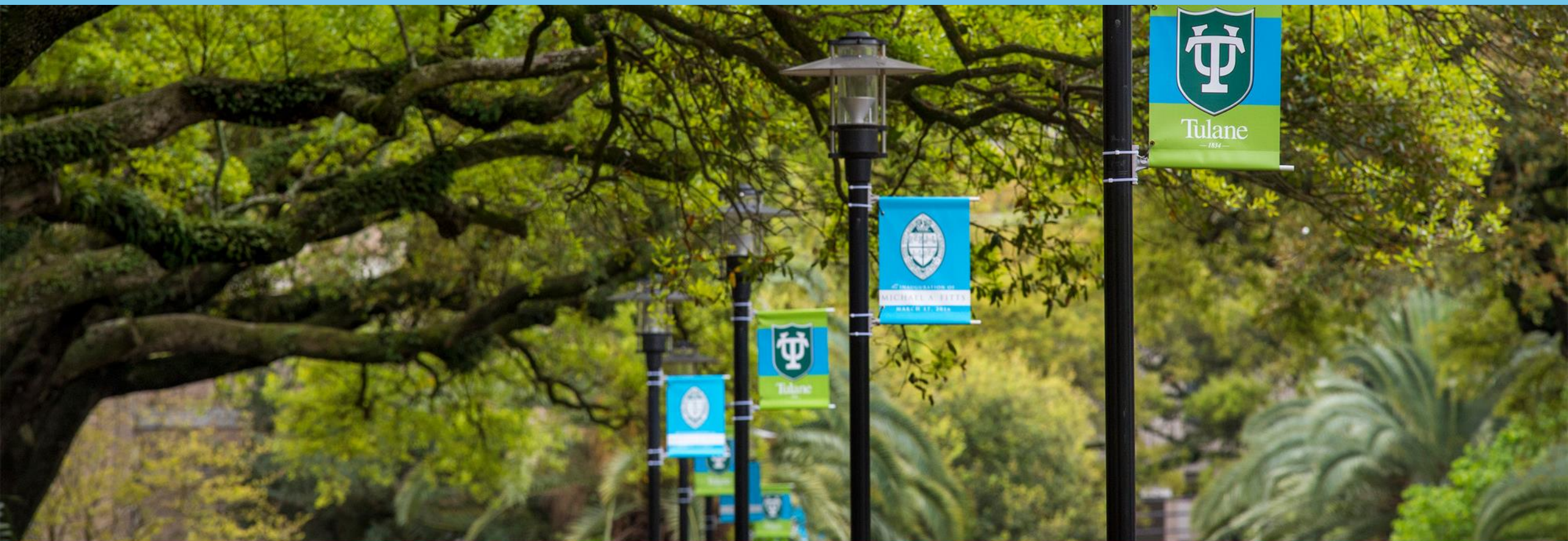
